The purpose of this standard is to facilitate safe and effective application of IEEE 802-based profiles in the context of medical device communication in the scope of the IEEE 1073 in which synchronization of medical device, patient, and clinical logistical information is required among heterogeneous real-time medical data processors.

Maximizing availability of real-time medical data can be critical to patient care outcomes, and a safe and effective means of integrating heterogeneous communicants is necessary to achieve that, especially in a mobile, wireless context, which is becoming increasingly necessary for medical devices to employ.
