Dear Larry:

This letter is written in response to your request that Hewlett Packard confirm to the IEEE that we will provide licenses under our US Patent #5,453,982, and other pending patents with respect to the proposed IEEE P1284.4 standard. In that regard:

In the event the proposed standard is adopted and the standard cannot be practiced without the use of Patent #5,453,982, Hewlett Packard and Genoa Technology, coholders of Patent #5,453,982 agree upon written request to grant a non-exclusive license under this patent on a nondiscriminatory basis and on reasonable terms and conditions for the purpose of implementing the standard.

I know of no other patents or pending patents held jointly by Hewlett Packard and any other party that would be necessary for a standard resulting in whole or in part from this contribution.

As to other patents held or pending for Hewlett Packard by itself, Hewlett Packard has not made a determination as to whether existing or pending patents are necessary for practicing the proposed standard, but agrees that a license under reasonable and nondiscriminatory terms and conditions will be made available for the purpose of implementing the standard, if such patents are later found to exist and are required for practicing the standard.

This letter does not grant any right to the IEEE with respect to Hewlett Packard copyrights or any intellectual property rights that relate to the proposed standard. Any party interested in the license described above may write to Joe Halpern at the address on the letterhead.

However, Hewlett Packard does agree to grant to the IEEE upon request a free, irrevocable license to incorporate text contained in this contribution and any modifications thereof in the creation of an IEEE standards publication even though it may include portions of this contribution; and at the IEEE's sole discretion to permit others to reproduce in whole or in part the resulting IEEE standards publication.
