

WHAT IS THE INDUSTRY CONNECTIONS PROGRAM?

The <u>Industry Connections (IC) program</u> helps incubate new standards and related products and services by facilitating collaboration among organizations and individuals as they hone and refine their thinking on rapidly changing technologies. The IC program offers an efficient, economical environment for building consensus and producing shared results. <u>IEEE SA</u> provides a basic level of support to all IC activities.

INDUSTRY CONNECTIONS ACTIVITIES

Industry Connections activities typically start with collaborative efforts in a technical domain, which may then evolve in several ways. Some may conclude after achieving their goals, while others transition into standards development within IEEE SA. Alternatively, these activities may integrate into existing IEEE Societies or Councils, or even develop into entirely new ones.


HOW DOES AN INDUSTRY CONNECTIONS ACTIVITY GET STARTED?

An IC activity starts when companies or individuals recognize a need for collaboration in a technical area. They submit an Industry Connections Activity Initiation Document (ICAID) to IEEE SA's Industry Connections Committee (ICCom). Once approved, participants meet in person or electronically. IEEE SA helps support the IC activity leadership including their policies and procedures, as they work toward shared goals.

WHERE DOES INDUSTRY CONNECTIONS FIT IN IEEE SA?

IC operates primarily in the early stages of the Standards Development Lifecycle, facilitating the transition from concept to development, and offers various consensusbuilding services throughout the lifecycle.

Stakeholders play a pivotal role in incubating new and emerging market-relevant standards within IEEE SA by contributing expertise, validating relevance, and ensuring continued value.
