Nortel Networks Corporation has patents and patent applications which may be essential for implementations of the IEEE 802.3 Standard or proposed amendments thereto. In that regard:

Nortel Networks Corporation will grant a nonexclusive license to Nortel patent claims that are essential for implementation of an existing IEEE 802.3 Standard on a nondiscriminatory basis and on reasonable terms and conditions, solely for use in implementing the standard, to any party that agrees to grant Nortel Networks and its corporate affiliates a reciprocal license under reasonable and nondiscriminatory terms for all of that party's patent claims that are essential for implementation of an existing IEEE 802.3 Standard.

This letter does not grant any right to the IEEE with respect to Nortel Networks Corporation copyrights or other intellectual property rights that relate to the proposed standard.
